Part II For the navigation of St. George's and the North Channels, comprising the East, North and West Coasts of Ireland, from Carnsore Point to Loop Head, and the West Coasts of England and Scotland, from Formy Point to Cape Wrath, with the Hebrides or Lewis Islands.
