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Résumé ou extrait : Présentation de l'éditeur : "In 2009 Major Richard Streatfeild and his men fought for six months against the Taliban in Sangin, northern Helmand. They were engaged in over 800 fire-fights. They were the target of more than 200 improvised explosive devices. Ten men in his company group were killed, 50 were wounded. This is their story--and it is the story, from the front line, of Western intervention in Afghanistan. His graphic personal account gives an inside view of the physical, psychological and political battle to come to terms with severe casualties and the extreme stress of battle while seeking the support of the local population. ...
