Résumé ou extrait : The U.S. Army again faces a major turning point. The last time the Army was drastically downsized - just after World War II - the result was the nearly catastrophic rout of its forces in Korea. Former chief of the Army's armor forces and coauthor of the landmark 1973 work *The United States Army in Transition (I)*, Lt. Gen. Frederic J. Brown was one of the key thinkers behind the Army's recent successes
His latest book establishes the next creative framework for dealing with the tough issues facing today's custodians of U.S. landpower. It will stimulate discussion among all concerned with America's security at this watershed in world history
