Today, the awkward truth is that the Lisbon institutions have brought more ambiguity than clarity about Europe's capacity and role in the world. To surmount this impasse, Carnegie Europe is reinvigorating the debate with new perspectives, fresh impulses, and thought-provoking ideas on this key policy field. By discussing long-
