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Résumé ou extrait : 2 TAF = Second Tactical Air Force NB : The success of the Luftwaffe in supporting its ground operations led the allies to examine its close air support ideas. The RAF's first effective close support operations came with the Desert Air Force, in support of the British Eighth Army. The Second Tactical Air Force was formed with squadrons mostly drawn from Fighter Command and would support the British 21st Army group consisting of the British Second Army and First Canadian Army.
