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Résumé ou extrait : Présentation de l'éditeur : "At a recent Association of the United States Army meeting, General David Perkins, commander of the Army Training and Doctrine Command, outlined a concept of future warfare known as Multi-Domain Battle, where the armed forces of the United States leverage the strength each possesses in their respective domains to achieve synergized effects on a future battlefield. Building on the AirLand Battle concept of the 1980s, which revolutionized inter-service cooperation between the air and ground domains, ushering in an era of unprecedented combat effectiveness highlighted by Operation Desert Storm, General Perkins laid out a vision whereby all domains, including air, land, maritime, space, cyberspace, as well as the electromagnetic spectrum, will be essential to future success."

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
