Résumé ou extrait : La 4ème de couv. indique : "While it might have been viable for states to isolate themselves from international politics in the nineteenth century, the intensity of economic and social globalisation in the twenty-first century has made this impossible. The contemporary world is an international world - a world of collective security systems and collective trade agreements. What does this mean for the sovereign state and 'its' international legal order ? Two alternative approaches to the problem of governance in the era of globalisation have developed in the twentieth century : universal internationalism and regional supranationalism. The first approaches collective action problems from the perspective of the sovereign equality of all States. A second approach to transnational governance has

tried to re-build majoritarian governmental structures at the regional scale. This collection of essays wishes to analyse - and contrast - the two types of normative and decisional answers that have emerged as responses to the international problems within our globalised world."
