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Résumé ou extrait : In this work, an internationally-respected authority in military ethics describes a wholly new kind of cyber conflict that has utterly confounded the predictions of earlier experts in information warfare. Comparing this state-sponsored hacktivism to the transformative impact of irregular warfare in conventional armed conflict, Lucas offers a critique of legal approaches to governance, and outlines a new approach to ethics and just war reasoning (grounded in the political philosophies of Alasdair MacIntyre, John Rawls, and Jürgen Habermas) that provides both a framework for understanding these newly-emerging norms of practice for cyber conflict, and the basis for a professional code of ethics for the new generation of cyber warriors.
