Résumé ou extrait : On June 7th and 8th, 2007, the Documentation Center of the Ecole militaire and the Centre for Study and Research of the Ecole militaire organised, in Paris, an international seminar on the main changes to the global geostrategic system since the year 2000. It was placed under the presidency of the director of the Higher military Education, director of the institute of higher national defence studies and director of the Centre of high military studies. This seminar was the occasion, through interventions and debates, to look at the global views of other countries on the fundamental strategic changes that have occurred, beyond the attacks of 11 september 2001 and, more generally since the end of the cold war and the desintegration of the Soviet Union and the subsequent reconstructions. The following proceedings are a long way from providing a comprehensive answer to the question raised and should not be construed as any kind of summary or conclusion. They only aim at providing everyone with some rich and varied information, food for thought in terms of strategic research.
